



**American Association of University Women (AAUW) Kansas State Board Scholarship
to attend the
National Conference for College Women Student Leaders**

The AAUW Kansas State Board is pleased to offer one incentive travel scholarship of up to \$750 for one female student to attend the National Conference for College Women Student Leaders (NCCWSL), May 27 – 30, 2020, at the University of Maryland, College Park.

The National Conference for College Women Student Leaders is the nation's premier conference for college women. It is a transformative experience for attendees and prepares them to be **the next generation of leaders**. Each attendee becomes a part of the conference's more than 35-year legacy.

At this four-day conference, college women will:

- Choose from more than 50 workshops that prepare them for life after college
- Meet inspiring role models including Women of Distinction awardees and speakers
- Make connections for life
- Discover their future from 100 graduate schools and employers
- Gain the confidence and skills to return to their campuses and communities ready to act

Estimated total cost of the conference is \$1,400. Applicant is required to apply to the AAUW National Scholarship for the cost of registration/housing/preconference activity. Should applicant not receive a National Scholarship, they are encouraged to seek other funding opportunities such as from Student Government chapters at their college/university, local AAUW branches or local businesses.

REQUIREMENTS

- Applicant must be a female student in good standing currently enrolled in a Kansas 2-or 4-year institution (2019-2020 academic year)
- Applicant must apply for an AAUW National NCCWSL Scholarship at <https://www.nccwsl.org/registration> before January 10, 2020
- Application must be typed and submitted in one complete portable document format (pdf) file, including 1) completed application, 2) references, and 3) proof of application for AAUW National NCCWSL Scholarship to auwksscholarships@gmail.com by January 10, 2020.
- Applicant must obtain the assistance of an adviser who will be responsible for mentoring the applicant through conference preparation, fund raising, if necessary, and the logistics of travel arrangements.
- Scholarship recipient must speak (preferably in person) at the AAUW State Annual Meeting held in Manhattan, Kansas in April 2021.
